- **Capt'n Jack's Tides and Currents Almanac** – buy new each year. Available at many marine outlets such as [LFS Marine](#). Approximately \$18.
- **Current Atlas, Canadian Hydrographic Service:** Canadian Hydrographic Service – great reference to see how the water is moving over all. Easiest used with Waggoner Tables (formerly Washburne Tables) or Current Atlas Lookup Tables downloaded from the internet. The Waggoner Tables must be purchased new each year. Both the Current Atlas and the Waggoner Tables are available at many marine outlets such as [LFS Marine](#). Approximately \$25 for the Atlas and \$8 for the Waggoner Tables. - **The New San Juan Current Guide** by Island Canoe. Out of print but handy reference for currents in the San Juan Islands if you can find a copy. Look for it in used book stores or online.
